REVIEW REPORT ON THE ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT TO THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF HONG KONG PLAYGROUND ASSOCIATION

(Incorporated in Hong Kong under Hong Kong Playground Association Ordinance)

We have audited the financial statements of Hong Kong Playground Association ("the Association") for the year ended 31 March, 2020 and have issued an unqualified auditor's report thereon dated 22 June, 2020.

We conducted our review of the attached Annual Financial Report on pages 2 to 6 of the Association for the year ended 31 March, 2020 in accordance with Practice Note 851 "Review of the Annual Financial Reports of Non-governmental Organisations" issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants. The review includes considering the procedures and records relevant to the preparation of the Annual Financial Report and performing procedures to satisfy ourselves that the Annual Financial Report has been properly prepared from the books and records of the Association, on which the above audited financial statements of the Association are based.

Review conclusions

On the basis of the results of our review and having regard to the audit procedures performed by us in relation to the audit of the financial statements of the Association for the year ended 31 March, 2020.

- a. in our opinion the Annual Financial Report has been properly prepared from the books and records of the Association; and
- b. no matters have come to our attention during the course of our review, which cause us to believe that the Association has not:
 - properly accounted for the receipt of Lump Sum Grant, Provident Fund and other social welfare subventions and expenditure in respect of Funding and Services Agreement activities and support services;
 - ii. kept separate Operating Income and Expenditure Account for each subvented service unit as required by the Lump Sum Grant Manual (LSG Manual) published by the Social Welfare Department of the Government of the HKSAR;
 - iii. prepared the Annual Financial Report in accordance with the format and requirements set out in LSG Manual; and
 - iv. employed the staff quoted in the Provident Fund arrangements during the year ended 31 March, 2020.

1. Lump Sum Grant

a. Basis of preparation

The Annual Financial Report (AFR) is prepared in respect of all Funding and Service Agreement (FSA) activities (including support services to FSA activities) funded by the Social Welfare Department under the Lumpsum Grant Subvention System. AFR is prepared <u>on cash basis</u>, that is, income is recognised upon receipt of cash and expenditure is recognised when expenses are paid. <u>Non-cash items</u> such as depreciation, provisions and accruals have not been included in the AFR.

b. Lump Sum Grant (excluding Provident Fund)

b. Lump Sum Grant This represents LSG (excluding Provident Fund) received for the year.

c. Provident Fund

This is Provident Fund received and contributed during the year.

Snapshot staff are defined as those staff occupying recognised or holding against subvented posts as at 1 April 2000.

6.8% and other posts represent those staff that are employed after 1 April 2000.

The Provident Fund received and contributed for staff under the Central Items have been shown under 3.

4. Rent and Rates
